Thesis Title: "Thinking Art Post-aesthetically: Beyond Expression, Experience and Consciousness."

Summary: Interrogating the fields of both art and philosophy, this dissertation enquires as to how certain practices of art might engage in what might be art's specific way of thinking, and consider the production and reception of art as a modality of knowing which displaces the modernist metaphysical notions of expression, intention, inner experience, and aesthetic pleasure. At the same time it examines the theoretical documents and practices of (i), conceptual art, and (ii) John Cage and Fluxus, in order to open the possibility for a non-aesthetic, and non-conceptual, encounter with the work of art, that does not jettison materiality and thinking.
